



General House Rules

We take our responsibility as hosts very seriously and consider the safety and wellbeing of everyone present part of that responsibility. You will be removed if you present any problem to the environment we choose to foster in our home, and you will be held responsible for any damage done.

Yes, we have a lot of rules. There is a whole separate set of rules on top of this for play nights. Please read thoroughly. If it's not a declared play night, there will be no sexual activities.

- We are a community, not a venue. Don't take advantage of our hospitality inappropriately.
- No vaccine, no entry, no excuse.
- Use the front door. Do NOT use the stairs on the side of the house and do NOT go past the white fence.
- There will be no smoking of any kind on the property. Several of us have sensitive lungs and can't tolerate smoke in or around the house, including on people's clothes. It's not a judgment; it's a health concern.
- Drugs and alcohol: Drink if you want, but don't get drunk. Use edibles if you want, but don't lose control. If you are not clear-headed, you will be asked to leave. On play nights, no recreational drugs or alcohol at all.
- No one under 21. Yes, 21. Not 18. We do not accept liability for anyone under 21 being present where alcohol is freely available, even if we aren't planning to drink. We often host vanilla events where children will be welcome to run around like a rabid pack. Please pay attention to individual events, as it will be noted when children are welcome, like full-day DnD sessions. Unless it is specifically noted that they are allowed, assume every event is 21+.
- My neighbors are very vanilla. In front of the house, keep it visually clean.
- No drama. Don't bring your "discrete arrangement" into our home. Don't argue about our vaccination rule or any other rule, for that matter. We don't need inflammatory discussions. Keep it civil. If civility ends, so does your invitation to our home.
- No one owes anyone else anything other than politeness. Not sex, not a scene, not their time, nothing. If you feel pressured in ANY way, please approach one of us to handle the situation. If you cannot be polite, you don't need to be here.

- Be respectful of others' physicality, gender identity, orientation, kinks, etc. On the flip side, respect the right of others not to be interested in those same things. Please do everyone the courtesy of respecting their preferences as they respect yours.
- If a door is locked, don't open it. Don't go places you don't have permission to be.
- Don't touch things that you don't have permission to touch. **THIS INCLUDES PEOPLE.** Ask before touching someone or their things.
- Allergies: we have a terrier/poodle mix that we call a dog. She's generally hypoallergenic, but not everyone is the same. We also have an Australian cattle dog puppy. She is VERY friendly; you've been warned. My allergies don't react to her because ACD's have a double layer coat, but that doesn't mean yours will be okay.
- Photography: Ask before taking pictures. Make sure only the subject is in the picture.
- Don't share any information about these events or those who attend, even with others in attendance. If someone doesn't use their real name in the community, you shouldn't introduce them by it. If you have concerns about someone or their behavior, bring it up to your hosts.
- Clean up after yourself.
